These Terms of Use govern your use of CAM and any associated applications or services owned or controlled by Otsuka Pharmaceutical Europe Limited incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 03456326 whose registered office is at 2 Windsor Dials, Arthur Road, Windsor SL4 United Kingdom (called "Otsuka," or "us/we/our" in the Terms of Use). We have worked with Click Therapeutics ("Click") on the development of CAM. Use of CAM is offered to you conditioned upon your acceptance without modification of these Terms of Use. Your use of CAM constitutes agreement to these Terms of Use.

## 1. Using CAM

## 1.1 For All CAM Users

## CAM Does Not Replace Your Healthcare professional's Medical Advice

CAM is a digital therapeutic intended for the treatment of major depressive disorder (MDD) in adults. It is intended to be used alongside standard of care and supported by a healthcare professional. CAM provides neurobehavioral treatment composed of three parts: cognitive emotional training, cognitive behavioral therapy-based psychotherapy lessons, and personalized messaging.

CAM is a UKCA-marked medical device and has been designed and manufactured to comply with the relevant Essential Requirements set out in the UK Medical Devices Regulations. Otsuka America Pharmaceutical, Inc., an affiliate of Otsuka, acts as the legal manufacturer of the device. Otsuka acts as the UK Responsible Person.

## 2. Changes to the Terms of Use and to CAM

Otsuka reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to change these Terms of Use at any time for any reason. Should Otsuka make any changes to these Terms of Use, we will post the revised Terms of Use to CAM, and the changes will be effective upon such posting. Otsuka encourages you to periodically review the Terms of Use. If you do not agree with any updates to these Terms of Use, do not continue to use CAM. Continued use of CAM after the effective date of a change to these Terms of Use constitutes acceptance of the updated version of the Terms of Use.

## 3. Acceptable Use and Restrictions on Use

CAM is available only to persons above the age of 18, located in the United Kingdom and for use in accordance with the Intended Use. If you do not meet these requirements, you may not use CAM.

You agree only to use CAM for the purposes for which they have been designed. You will comply with these Terms and all applicable laws, rules, and regulations and will not encourage or promote any activity that violates these Terms.

## Additional Restrictions

You agree that you will not:

- use CAM for any unlawful purpose or to promote illegal activities;
- try to interfere in any way with CAM's networks or network security or try to use CAM to gain unauthorised access to any other computer system, or other user's account;
- interfere or try to interfere with the proper functioning of CAM, or damage any data or information associated with CAM;
- transmit any harmful, malicious, or unauthorised software such as: viruses, time bombs, Trojan horses, worms, surveillance codes, other computer programming routines;
- make any automated use of CAM, or take any action that we deem to impose or to potentially impose an unreasonable or disproportionately large load on our servers or network infrastructure;

- bypass any measures we take to restrict access to CAM or use any software, technology or device to scrape, spider or crawl CAM or harvest or manipulate data, or access any other user's information (unless explicitly granted permission in writing);
- post or link to any content (verbal, images, or otherwise) to social media, or any other public-facing forums, related to CAM or your use of CAM, given proprietary product development considerations;
- post or link to any malicious content or offensive material; or
- send harassing, discriminatory, disparaging, defamatory, or inappropriate messages about CAM.

If we determine that you have violated any of the above restrictions or any other term or condition of these Terms, we reserve the right, in our sole discretion, to discontinue your use of CAM.

#### 4. Privacy Policy

Personal Information collected in connection with CAM will be maintained in accordance with our posted Privacy Policy.

#### 5. Accounts, Passwords, and Security

CAM requires that you set up an account, including providing a preferred name, email address, password, and phone number. You acknowledge that you are entirely responsible for preserving the confidentiality of your account, including your preferred name, email address, password, and phone number and for any and all activity that occurs under your account. You should not share your password with anyone. If you feel that your security has been compromised, you can change your password at any time by going to the edit profile screen and following the instructions.

You must notify Otsuka as soon as possible via the contact information provided below if you discover any unauthorised access or use of your account or access credentials, or any other breach of security.

As part of your use of CAM, you may be required to use a smartphone to enter, access, or update your personal information. You understand that you are responsible for safeguarding and securing your smartphone and any associated credentials (such as your account password). If you leave your smartphone unattended, or if it is lost or stolen, you understand that personal information may be accessible to others. CAM will automatically log users out of accounts 6 months after the latest login, after a period of inactivity up to 6 months long.

You acknowledge that there are certain security, corruption, transmission error, and access availability risks associated with using smartphones and you hereby expressly assume such risks. You acknowledge that Otsuka is not responsible for third-party access to your smartphone or CAM that results from theft or misappropriation of your smartphone. We caution you to guard your smartphone and account password against any unauthorised access by others.

We are not responsible for the security of email or texting systems used by any patients, and we cannot guarantee that information will be encrypted on these systems.

#### 6. User Information

In these Terms, your "User Information" means any material that you submit to us through your use of CAM. You agree only to provide User Information that is accurate, and you agree to keep your User Information current, including your email address and phone number.

You own your User Information. By submitting or uploading User Information to CAM, you grant Otsuka the right to access, view, display, reproduce, adapt, publish, translate, store, host, cache, maintain, modify,

distribute and otherwise use your User Information in any manner, subject to restrictions on use of personal information under the Privacy Policy and applicable law. The right you grant to Otsuka includes an unrestricted, worldwide, irrevocable, non-exclusive, perpetual, fully-paid, royalty-free, transferrable license. You also grant Otsuka the right to sub-license these rights through multiple tiers. We have no obligation to screen, edit, or monitor your User Information, but we may, in our discretion, delete or remove User Information at any time and for any reason.

You may be asked to participate in surveys, questionnaires, and other activities from time to-time to share insights about your experience with CAM, including your comments, suggestions, ideas or other feedback ("Feedback"). We and Click may use your Feedback to help us improve CAM and related services, and it may be used to develop other commercial products or services. Providing Feedback on CAM is voluntary and does not affect your ability to use CAM. You are hereby agreeing that we can contact you via email, telephone or text message to request your Feedback.

If you choose to provide us with Feedback, you agree that we and Click have an unrestricted right to use it, and you are not entitled to receive any compensation.

## 7. No Unlawful or Prohibited Use; Intellectual Property Rights

To use CAM, you must be at least 18 years of age and fully able, competent, and authorised to enter into and be bound by these Terms of Use. Minor children are not eligible to use CAM. We do not knowingly attempt to solicit or receive any information from minor children. If you are under the age of 18, you are not authorised to access, or to submit any content or information to, CAM.

Any misuse of CAM may lead to the termination of your account at our sole discretion. You agree not to interrupt or attempt to interrupt the operation of CAM in any way. Any conduct by you that, in our sole discretion, restricts, inhibits, or interferes with the ability of any other user to enjoy CAM or infringes on the privacy of any other user of CAM will not be tolerated, including by means of hacking, scraping, or defacing any portion of CAM, or by engaging in spamming, flooding, or other disruptive activities.

You are granted a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use CAM strictly in accordance with these Terms of Use. All components of CAM, including any service, text, photographs, graphics, icon buttons, images, screen layouts, designs, artwork, names, logos, trademarks, service marks, and data as well as the compilation and design thereof ("Content"), and any software or hardware used by CAM, are the property of Otsuka (or its licensors) and may be protected by trademark, copyright, patent, and other laws, rules, and regulations that protect intellectual property and proprietary rights. CAM may include both Content owned or controlled by Otsuka and Third Party Content (defined below) owned and controlled by third parties and licensed to Otsuka. CAM, including materials and information contained on CAM, is intended for individual use only and may not be used, sold, reproduced, distributed, or in any way disseminated by you. You will use CAM solely for your personal use and will make no other use of CAM or its components without the express written permission of Otsuka and any other trademark owner. Unless expressly permitted by applicable law, you will not modify, publish, transmit, reverse engineer, participate in the transfer or sale, create derivative works, or in any way exploit, in whole or in part, any components of CAM without our express written consent. You agree that you do not acquire any ownership rights in CAM or its components. We do not grant you any licenses, expressed or implied, to the intellectual property of Otsuka, except as expressly authorised by these Terms of Use.

All trademarks, trade names and logos appearing on or through CAM are owned by us or licensed by us or Click. The Otsuka name and logo and all other Otsuka names, marks, logos, and other identifiers are trademarks and service marks of Otsuka. The Click name and logo and all other Click names, marks, logos, and other identifiers are trademarks and service marks of Click. Names, marks, logos, and other identifiers of third parties, including third party healthcare professionals, are trademarks and service marks of their

respective owners. You may not use or display any Otsuka or Click trademarks, trade names, logos, or other identifiers without our prior written permission. We reserve all rights.

#### 8. Third Party Content and Services

CAM may contain or interact with third party applications, websites, products, services (the "Third Party Content"). Your use of Third Party Content may be subject to additional terms and conditions and privacy policies. We may suspend or withdraw or restrict the availability of CAM for any reason, including business and operational reasons. We will try to give you reasonable notice of any suspension or withdrawal.

#### 10. Limitation of Liability

Nothing in these Terms limits or excludes our liability that, under applicable law, cannot be limited or excluded, including liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence, liability for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.

If we fail to comply with the Terms, we are responsible for loss or damage you suffer that is a foreseeable result of our breaking this agreement or our failing to use reasonable care and skill, but we are not responsible for any loss or damage that is not foreseeable or that is otherwise indirect or consequential. Loss or damage is foreseeable if either it is obvious that it will happen or if, at the time the contract was made, both we and you knew it might happen. In no circumstance will we be liable for any loss of profit, goodwill, revenue, anticipated savings, or any loss or corruption of data. To the maximum extent permitted by law, our aggregate liability under this Agreement is limited to £100.

## 12. Termination

These Terms are effective unless and until terminated by either you or Otsuka. You may terminate these Terms at any time, provided that you discontinue any further access or use of CAM. We also may terminate these Terms, in our sole discretion, at any time and may do so and accordingly deny you access to CAM.

## 13. Miscellaneous

These Terms constitute the entire agreement between you and Otsuka regarding your access to, and use of CAM. Except as expressly stated in these Terms, only Otsuka or you may enforce these Terms. If a portion of these Terms is determined to be unlawful, void, or unenforceable, it will not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions, and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect. The following provisions survive the expiration or termination of these Terms: all definitions; Otsuka's Ownership Rights; User Information; Third Party Content; Limitation of Liability; Indemnity; Choice of Law and Venue; and Miscellaneous. If CAM is made available using the iOS operating system or has been downloaded from the Apple, Inc. ("Apple") app store ("Apple App Store") then:

(a) You and Otsuka acknowledge and agree that this Agreement is solely between you and Otsuka, not Apple and that Apple has no responsibility for CAM.

(b) Your use of CAM must comply with the terms of service of the Apple App Store.
